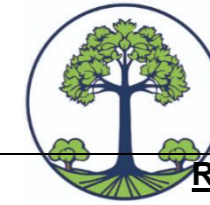


# Summer Term 2026 Curriculum Map



**Humanities**

In **Geography**, Anning Class will be comparing the difference between Templecombe and a large city in the United Kingdom. We will discuss the similarities and differences of living in these places.



In **History** we will learn about the Roman Empire, the invasion of the United Kingdom and the functions of Hadrian's Wall.

**Science**

In Science, Anning Class will be exploring the life cycle of a flowering plant as well as learning about the functions and purpose of each part of the plant.



We will also be exploring light and reflection. We will discuss natural and artificial light sources and the differences between them.

**RE**

Anning Class will explore Hinduism and how it formed. We will discuss the core beliefs of the religion as well as which places are special to Hindus.

Anning will also explore more about sacred texts across religions. We will compare books from all religions.



**PSHE**

Anning Class will be discussing the 'team' that is around us in life – considering how each person is unique and how they are important to us.

We will also be exploring the wider world around us – celebrating the many differences that we can encounter across the globe. Anning will also be developing our understanding of our bodies and the importance of keeping ourselves safe and healthy.

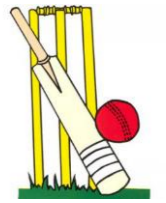
Summer Term 2026

**Art and D&T**

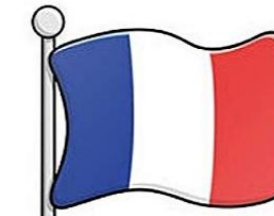
In **Art** this term, Anning Class will be exploring the process of printing to achieve a repeated pattern, citing artists such as Cath Kidston and William Morris.

In French, Anning Class will be learning about items around our classroom.

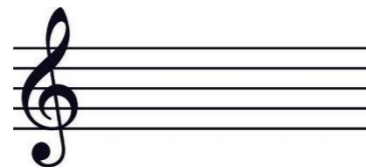


We will be recapping all of our learning from this year so far, ensuring that we are confident with topics such as colour and food preferences.
